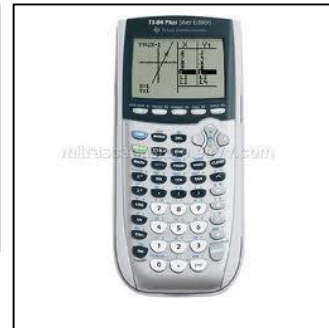
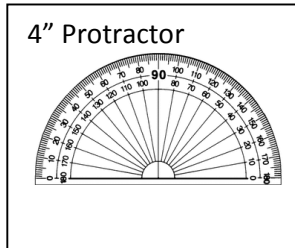

Math Supplies Checklist – Dedicated to Mrs. Magill & Mr. Adams Math Class ONLY

To ensure students arrive in class with supplies each day, pencils, eraser, highlighter, red pen, protractor and small ruler are kept in the pencil bag and used **ONLY** for math class. ☺

- Three-Ring Binder (size is student's preference)
- Supply of heavy duty, hole-punched graph paper
(Better quality paper is usually sold in pads. Please do not get the thin stuff.)
- Pencils – at least two, mechanical or otherwise
- Big Eraser
- Highlighter
- Red or Orange Pen – for making corrections
- Small (4") Protractor



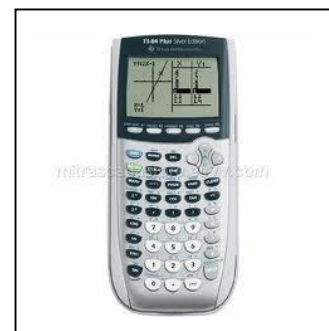
- Small (6") Ruler – with centimeters and inches
- Pencil Bag – with three holes to clip into 3-Ring Binder
- Graphing Calculator **REQUIRED** for grades 9 – 12 only
Please get any version of the TI-84 (see picture) or TI-83 so that everyone has the same operating system. Used graphing calculators are available online.



- Thumbscrew Compass (9th only) – The goal is to get a better compass than the “nearly useless” ones sold in the school supply section of most stores. Better ones can be found at Office Depot, Staples, or online.

 - Thumb Screw type of compass is more accurate and less frustrating to use than the sliding type, which, oddly enough, slides during use.
